

Session 2: Surgical periodontal therapy + Crown Lengthening


- Surgical management of periodontal disease.

- Introduction to micro-surgical techniques and minimally invasive surgical therapies (MIST).
- Cosmetic and functional crown lengthening procedures in general practice.
- The role of Digital Smile Design in achieving ideal cosmetic results in cosmetic crown lengthening.






Session 3: Regenerative Therapies + Autotransplantation

- Explore the modern era of periodontal regenerative therapies.
- Understand the keys to regenerative surgery and protocol for success.
- Gain a thorough knowledge of biomaterials for regeneration and their clinical indications for use.
- Advanced microsurgical techniques including papilla preservation, minimally invasive surgical techniques, single flap approaches and entire papilla preservation flaps.
- Comprehensive management of combined periodontic and endodontically involved teeth including endodontic surgical techniques.
- Introduction to the biological basis for Autotransplantation and predictable treatment protocols.
- Hands on clinical training on periodontal models.



Session 4: Soft Tissue Plastic Surgeries & Phenotype Modification

- Periodontal plastic surgery focusing on the classic mucogingival surgeries including frenectomy,
- apical repositioned flaps, lateral repositioning flaps, papillary flaps, free gingival grafts.
 - Exposure to different sources and techniques for connective tissue harvesting.
- Hands on clinical soft tissue plastic training on Pig Jaws



Session 5: Recession Coverage & Perio-Restorative Interface

- Periodontal plastic surgeries focusing on recession coverage procedures.
- Develop an understanding of surgery involving single and multiple teeth with a focus on Coronally Advanced Flaps and Modified Tunnel techniques.
- Understand the perio-restorative interface and combining plastic surgeries with restorative treatments to achieve harmonious pink/white aesthetics.
- Understand the benefits of Biologically Oriented Preparation Technique (BOPT) and the role of vertical restorative preparations
- The critical role of orthodontic treatments with a focus on intrusion and extrusion to improve soft tissue contour for complex perio-restorative cases.
- Develop skills to manage removable prosthesis in periodontally compromised dentition using Scandanvian Design dentures





Session 6: Peri-implant Disease Management

- Identify the current knowledge on biology, aetiology, pathogenesis of peri-implant disease.
- Develop a deeper knowledge on prevention and management of peri-implant disease.
- Hard tissue and soft tissue surgical techniques for the compromised implant.
- Clinical protocols for implant maintenance in the general practice.
- Latest technologies for decontaminating failing implants.



Session 7: Implant Soft Tissue Plastics

- Identify the different time points for soft tissue augmentation to improve the dental implant outcome.
- Develop surgical skills to develop soft tissue prior to implant placement, at the time of implant placement and surgical uncover.
- Developing natural emergence profiles around implants and appreciate the importance of critical and subcritical restorative contour.
- Advanced surgical techniques for implants in the aesthetic zone.
- Hands on clinical training on implant models and pig jaws.
